Windy Ridge Multi Use Trail: Greenstone trail craft design plan, 7 people toured the proposed trail area for 2 1/2 hours, vast majority is multi use, East/West stormwater management required to meet regulations

Skate Park: Design proposed phase 1 pump track 20,000 sqaure feet of impervious area. Project cost 40,000. Looking to have concrete donated, stormwater management next step as well as style of rail to be determined. \$14,000 in bank, anything over 30 grand has to go out for bid
