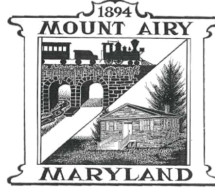

The June minutes were approved with a few minor corrections
Chair Report: Chairman Riegel went over the upcoming town events as well as the July Planning commission meeting and August master plan work session
Council Report: Councilwoman Reed reported that the council reallocated \$5,000 towards future skate park project, flat iron public hearing is scheduled before the September town council meeting begins. The council will take a vote in October with 9 options. She also mentioned that there are 2 resolutions going to the planning commission rezoning Beck property, and the APFO

Guests:

Saad Chaudry: Brittany Manor Basketball league: Saad had been working with Howard county along with other private schools. He is looking into camps for the spring, 2 days a week, for profit organization. Individuals to train, working with schools. Discussed possible fees, part time business, 3 hour sessions, 1 weekend each season morning, and afternoon sessions. Mike will send rental agreement to Saad.

Updates:

Bryson Field: Repaired
East West SM- Prospect divergence, clear signage
Windy Ridge: Tree down, PW notified, trail maintenance
Wildwood Park: Fountain completed July 8th, public service announcement stay off fountain signs will be posted
Twin Arch Park: Damage wild fox caught in net, MAYAA ordered replacements, construction extension to parking lot area
Summit Ridge: Soccer fields ruts filled with crabgrass, police notified
Watkins Park: Vandalism, 2nd light vandalized, PW replacing
AED bi monthly checking: EV charger not functional, resident submitted form followed with the town engineer to see who is resolving problem
Rails to Trails: Closing for construction mid August to January. Approx 400 x 8 ft wide boardwalk to be installed, town view stormwater management restoration
Beautification Updates: Busy weeding gardens , adding plants to gardens in September, renovating small garden at wildwood

Park Vists:

Village Gate Park: Tennis courts, parking area, cracks along the court, on list every fall of projects to get done correctly. Playground in good shape as well as access trail

Windy Ridge MB Trail: \$5,000 released for the design. Pat Ellis is contacting Greenstone to verify the quote provided.
MAYAA Shed: Tim Washabaugh MAYAA football commissioner is coordinating with PW, material prices are still high
Summit Ridge Playground: Reviewing grant options
Skate Park: Budget amendment of \$5,000 in general fund
Park Enhancements: Pumptrack intro video, cost estimates from American ramp compan, 3 different types of ramps. 23 x 54 \$48,000, 23 x 74 \$60,000, 54 x 34 \$78,000

Camp Night: Discussed movie options Scott made motion we go with Shrek Marc 2nd motion passes, Slim Harrison will play, Ashley looking into ice cream truck.

New Business:

Wildwood Park RailingL Resident request fielded by Councilman Domotor. Stair handrail, est cost \$1000.00, researching black wrought iron to match existing fencing. Temporary wooden handrail was never replaced. Next Budget cycle

Master Plan: Long term Needs? Matrix, will review offline have it done by August meeting, Joint commission meeting being planned for the fall
