The Meeting was called to order at 7:05 following the Pledge of Allegiance

The July meeting minutes were approved

Chair Report: Chairman Riegel brought up the latest town events since the last meeting.

Council Report: Councilwoman Reed reported the last town council meeting was held on 8/2, short meeting, Next council meeting will be on 9/13, before the regular meeting there will be a public hearing on the flat iron building. Oktoberfest will be held on 9/25 on main street, \$2,000 was raised from Watkins play place for the ADA playground.

Park Updates:

Prospect: Street hockey/pickleball, removed damaged hockey goal shade structure in active planning.

East/West: Stormwater Management making progress

Watkins: St Andrews outlet not working

Rails to trails: Closing within a few days for construction signs will be posted

Wildwood Stairs: Pavers loose and unstable, safety concern. Coordinated with beautification, Barney Quinn town engineer, and Council members Domotor and Reed

Beatification: Cleared space in wildwood park expect for shrubs. New plantings and natives, signs will be posted

Staff Report:

Camp Night, 60 attended, BSA troop 529 and 1161 participated. Wagner's and Wal Mart donated food. MAYAA softball is moving along with the shed. Coach Saad is working on details for holding a Basketball clinic at Watkins. Windy Ridge trail work day was successful.

Unfinished Business:

Windy Ridge Mountain Bike Trail: Trail design on hold, new grant app has been submitted for trail design, includes full environmental impact study. Greenstone agreed to keep original quote. The Ellis's walked the property with Greenstone.

MAYAA Shed: Construction is expected to start soon. Tim Washabaugh sent a email to FCLL at the end of July. As of Now Scott Nelson from MAYAA purchased shed. Should be up by next week.

Summit Ridge Playground: Submitted grant app, same grant that has been applied for ADA playground.

Skate Park: Met with reps to discuss planning and potential locations. 3 potential locations, preferred location replacement of sand volleyball, 2nd location around Watkins play place, 3rd location across the tennis courts. The board discussed all the options.

New Business:

Village Gate Pathway: Behind tennis courts issue with stormwater running down town owned land, Chairman Riegel spoke with the residents to make sure it was the right issue.
