The meeting was called to order at 7:02 following the Pledge of Allegiance. The August minutes were approved with some minor adjustments.

Chair Report: Chairman Riegel went over all the town events that have occurred since the last meeting.

Council Report: Chariman Riegel gave the council report. There are several public hearings set for the next town council meeting on October 4th. Oktoberfest is on September 25th. Riegler annexation potential means for accessing windy ridge property has been sent to the planning commission, CSX property has been approved. Longtime board member Drew Heck was recognized for his longtime service on the board at the last town council meeting. The next town council meeting will be on October 4th

Staff Report:

Caboose: Open weekends nearly 100 visitors since 9/1

Rails to trails: Closed, new signs for actual closure, through January of 2022.

Field Scheduling: MAYAA and FCLL working together on scheduling

Maintenance: Nancy and Brian from public works are creating requirements for use of town fields

Lighting: Use of lights at the Johnson field in Twin Ridge must be off by 10PM, Watkins 11PM Max. Unlighted portion considered closed at dusk.

Unfinished Business:

Windy Ridge multi use trail: Flooding issues after storms, looking for more erosion run off. Town was awarded \$50,000 LPPI grant for comprehensive design work. Several board members along with the Ellis's walked the property last Friday. Proceeding with Greenstone trail craft for design.

MAYAA Shed: Pad location has been marked. Board member Washabaugh had met with amish customs and C&C landscaping. Hoping to be finished within next week.

Summit Ridge Playground: Grant application in process

Skate park location: Narrowed to 4 locations, adjacent to pavilion, south of dog park, alternate east of play place, and alternate east of the parking lot. Board discussed options, area below dog park is least favorite option, board agreed to walk through with reps, down to 2 options.

Park Visits:

Prospect: Chairman Riegel visited prospect and gave update on recent status. He addressed hollow metal barriers being worn out and needing replaced. Playground equipment in good shape, chain link along the fence is tearing up needs replaced. Pavilion up for new business soon.

Patuxent River Trail: Example of Mountain Bike trail, walked it yesterday

Chairman Riegel went over all the upcoming events
