The meeting was called to order at 7:02 following the Pledge of Alligiance. The September meeting minutes were approved with a few minor adjustments.

Chair Report: Chairman Riegel went over the most recent town events since the last meeting, the next meeting is 11/18, need volunteer to lead next meeting

Council Report: Councilwoman Reed reported Oktoberfest this year was the most successful one, \$17,500.00 raised, she also went over goals for the junior task force. Tentative meeting with county commissioners and town council on Nov 23 regarding Harrison Lashier annexation agreements. Rezoning of Beck property approved at last council meeting, cell tower ordinance tabled. Several public hearings next month, charter ammendments, and flat iron building will be discussed at the next council meeting.

New Business:

APFO open space requirements: Chapter 98 of town code requires to give back 10% back to the town only if adequate. Town owns 213 acres, needs 290 to be adequate, 83 acres inadequate.
