**I. Call to Order and Pledge**

**II. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes**

**III. Staff Updates**

Mount Airy Police Department Chief Rietz: The Chick-Fil-A issue with U-turns is starting to slow. Enforcement will be continued. Rising Ridge Drive will be enforced, Main Street will continue to be an enforcement area.

More delineators around Chick-Fil-A to prevent U-turns.

North end of Century Drive is supposed to connect Maryland 27 at Center Street.

## VI. Old Business

### a. Speed and Traffic Studies

Lynne Galletti: November Study is on Streets and Roads section under Boards and Commissions, on the Mount Airy MD Gov website

Officer Brooks and Town staff went over areas around town to redo traffic studies. Raised crosswalks could be expanded into further neighborhoods to calm traffic.

### b. Rising Ridge Road speeding update

Covered by the council liaison Lynne Galletti. The responses on the new stops and raised crosswalks have generally been positive.

### c. Car Seat Safety

Waiting on Carroll County Health Department and the Fire Company for a response on the car seat check. The location for the car seat check would be Watkins Park, possibly in the Spring. Will follow up on this in March.

## VII. New Business

### a) Citizen submittals

Comment– New traffic median makes the road narrow going towards 27, making it a risk for cars.

Response: Roundabout construction is set to begin around Spring/Summer 2022 and will alleviate those issues.

Comment- New stop signs on prospect road would be bad, instead add caution and flashing light posts.

Council Liaison Lynne: The stop signs are replaced with yield signs. Alternatives are being considered.
