

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY
ORDINANCE NO. 2020-3**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2019-3, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY ADDING \$222,000 TO THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE ANNUAL ROAD REPAVING PROJECT WITH FUNDS COMING FROM A STREETS & ROADS RESERVE ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Annual Paving Project for Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 included repaving West Ridgeville Boulevard, Hillcrest Avenue, Fairview Avenue, Oak Street and Maple Avenue, and it was discovered that unforeseen conditions existed that required additional repairs and improvements to these roads, which resulted in additional costs; and

WHEREAS, West Ridgeville Boulevard required repairs and an additional six inches of asphalt to help prevent future flooding; and

WHEREAS, Hillcrest Avenue, Fairview Avenue, Oak Drive and Maple Avenue required repairs to the subgrade of the road bed; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to allocate funds for these additional expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2019-3 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 for the Town of Mount Airy on May 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2019-3 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 be, and hereby is, amended to add \$222,000 to the Annual Road Construction and Paving line item for the additional repairs needed to complete the annual paving project, with funding coming from a Streets & Roads Reserve Investment Account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2019-3 shall remain unchanged and as is.
